Subject: The Federal Deficit Reduction Act of 2005, 42 U.S.C. §1396(a)(68)

Section 6032 of the Federal Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 ("DRA") requires St. Joseph's Health to assist in preventing, detecting and addressing fraud, waste and abuse in federal health care programs by taking certain actions, including establishing written policies for employees, contractors and agents that provide detailed information about federal and state false claims statutes and penalties, and whistleblower protections.

SJH has established written policies and is making them available to you as required by the DRA. The policies are:

- False Claims Liability, Anti-retaliation Protections, And Detecting And Responding To Fraud
- Sanction And Exclusion List Monitoring

These policies are also available in PolicyManager which is accessible on the SJH intranet as well as on the SJH website at https://stjosephshealth.org/corporate-compliance.

St. Joseph's Health is committed to conducting business in an ethical and honest manner and within the bounds of the law. The Corporate Compliance Program has been established to prevent the occurrence of illegal or unethical behavior, to stop any such behavior as soon as reasonably possible after it has been discovered, to discipline the individuals involved (including those who know of violations but fail to report them), and to recommend and implement changes in policy and procedure necessary to avoid a recurrence of any prior violation.

SJH encourages individuals to bring forward information and/or complaints about violations of state or federal law, SJH policy, rules or regulations.
